The mission of New Horizon Child Care centers is “to open ‘New Horizons’ of self-esteem and potential for the little people entrusted to our care, their families, and our employees by providing and continuously improving the best child development on the planet.” These centers provide an early education that combines stimulating activity with loving attention, enabling children to become emotionally secure, physically capable, socially competent and intellectually curious.

The Savage facility occupies some 11,000 square feet and houses a total of 172 children including 24 infants, 28 toddlers, 90 pre-schoolers and 30 school-age children.

Winfield Townhomes

Winfield Townhomes are located at 141st and Huntington Avenue in Savage, adjacent to the MVTA's Savage Park & Ride lot. The rental townhomes feature two- and three-bedroom designs opened in late 2000.

Constructed by Shelter Corporation, the 134 townhomes offer such on-site amenities as a community room, high-speed internet access, digital satellite television, full-size washer and dryer, microwave, central air/heat and attached garage parking.

The MVTA

Vision: The Minnesota Valley Transit Authority is a transit provider that excels in transportation services that promote effective alternatives to the automobile in highway corridors. The system employs an integrated network that moves people to destinations.

Mission: The MVTA provides efficient, cost-effective, comfortable and state-of-the-art facilities and equipment to transport people to their destinations.

The Minnesota Valley Transit Authority (MVTA) was founded in 1990 as a joint powers agency serving the cities of Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eagan, Rosemount and Savage.

Since its founding, the MVTA has grown to be the third-largest transit agency in the State of Minnesota, currently transporting about 9,500 riders on an average weekday. Express bus ridership accounts for about 85 percent of that ridership. The MVTA carried its 25 millionth rider in February 2007.

The MVTA operates a fleet of more than 110 vehicles ranging from small buses to 45' coaches.

The MVTA's 2007 operating budget is \$15.5 million, with more than 85 percent of that figure directly funding transit operations.

In addition to the Savage Park & Ride, the MVTA operates other facilities including the Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eagan and 157th St. Transit Stations, the Burnsville and Eagan Bus Garages and the Palomino Hills, Heart of the City and Blackhawk park & ride lots.
