We understand that due to your circumstances, it is not feasible for you to fold the stroller as stated in MVTA's stroller policy.

MVTA's stroller policy (found on <https://www.mvta.com/new-riders/rules-of-the-road/>)

Strollers are all about safety. So please remove your child(ren) from the stroller, collapsing it to stow with you in your seat. Strollers should not be placed in aisles, in front of doorways or in the wheelchair area.

MVTA is granting you an exemption from our stroller policy and are allowing you to ride without having to fold your stroller before boarding the bus. You may use this letter as proof of your granted exception if an operator asks you to fold your stroller. Please be prepared to show this document (or a picture of this document) each time you board the bus.

Once onboard, you must make every reasonable effort to keep your stroller as close to you as possible and ensure it is secured at all times. MVTA is not responsible for any damage or injury caused from unsecured strollers. You are responsible for the safety of your child.

We value your patronage and hope this arrangement will make it easier for you to continue to use our service.
